- 1. Make sure your deposit was sent in (it buys your pumpkins). Your balance will be due immediately following the event.**
- 2. Remember we're a rain or shine event. In case of bad weather be prepared with indoor alternatives. We bring huge tarps, cages and other supplies so it's not a big deal (we take the mess with us when we leave).**
- 3. How do I prepare for an indoor event? It's usually best to use one large room. We'll setup different stations for each activity we offer. Should one large room be unavailable, we'll use 2-3 smaller ones so don't worry.**
- 4. How long does the pumpkin patch last? It depends on how many children. Plan on 1-2 hours.**
- 5. Make sure you send out the attached parent forms. They're prepared so you can charge the parents if you'd like (some facilities make money on our event).**
- 6. Make sure to put up the attached poster so your parents will be prepared for this event.**
- 7. We have live animals so check for allergies**
- 8. Have your camera charged and ready. There will be lots of opportunities for pictures.**
- 9. Prepare your staff to have a ball and get involved just like the kids. Hey Director, come on out and take a peek for yourself, You'll love the kids reactions.**
- 10. Get ready to have a great time and enjoy yourself with out all the hassle and stress of taking the kids on an off location field trip. It's all coming right to you front door.**
